The Montgomery County Green Business
Certification Program recognizes restaurants* certified through third party certification programs. The county will provide a one-time subsidy toward the cost of certification—50% of the fee up to \$1,000. Restaurants are responsible for ongoing fees required to maintain certification. The subsidy is available to the first 40 restaurants that certify.

Restaurants certified by any of the four major third party certification programs identified below will automatically become Montgomery County Certified Green Businesses and will be listed in the county's Green Business Directory.

B Lab offers a single level of certification, and this is recognized by the Montgomery County Green Business Certification Program. However, to be recognized, a business must achieve an above-average score on the Environment section of the B Impact Assessment.

The Green Business Network is a division of Green America and offers two levels of certification: Gold and Green; however, only Gold Certification will be recognized by the Montgomery County Green Business Certification Program.
